INTRODUCTION

This Amendment No. 06 to Basic Ordering Agreement No. BOA-008-16-2012 is entered into by and between the UChicago Argonne LLC on behalf of the Integrated Contractor Purchasing Team (hereinafter called "contractor") and Anixter (hereinafter called "seller").

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Amendment No. 06 is to by mutual written consent of both the Argonne National Laboratory and the Anixter Corporation is to extend the Agreement period of performance through October 31, 2020 and clarify both the pricing and the reporting requirements under this Agreement.


AGREEMENT

Article 1-Scope of Work

Article 1 is hereby modified by exercising by mutual written consent that the period of performance is extended through October 31, 2020. The seller hereby agrees to provide quarterly sales volume and savings report by sites per the reporting requirement established in Appendix B starting December 31, 2018 for the first Quarter of FY-19. The seller will coordinate on behalf of any qualified small business resellers that provide Anixter products under this Agreement to any site on the quarterly reporting and that is Anixter's responsibility. Additionally the pricing will be consistent with the guidelines as identified and detailed in Appendix A.

All other terms, conditions and provisions of the Subcontract shall remain in full force and effect. The parties have executed this Amendment No. 06, effective as of the date of the Subcontractor's signature.

APPENDIX A Pricing

1. All vendor items on the current ICPT master parts list will have a delivered (using ground delivery service) price of at least 20% off list. This will serve as a "do not exceed price". If a manufacturer's pricing rises, the ICPT pricing will rise consistent with the 20% off of list. Vendors may be added consistent with the agreed pricing parameters.

The present vendors on the master list are:

- Bline
- Compulink
- Commscope
- Corning
- CPI
- Ortronics
- Panduit

- Transition

2. Each facility is encouraged to work with the local Anixter office to negotiate Market Basket or "Registered" pricing for that specific facility. Anixter personnel will work together with sites to develop a strategy for steeper discounts with manufacturers/vendors supporting that facility.

Present facilities with Market Basket or registered pricing include:

- INL
- SLAC
- Nevada National Security Site
- Oak Ridge National Laboratory

3. Each facility may order directly from Anixter or through a small business partner which can be facilitated by the local Anixter office. Government Scientific Source has served as that small business partner for a number of facilities. Ronco is the recognized small business partner at NNSS. There is no additional markup or premium paid by the sites that go through a small business partner.

APPENDIX B

Data Reporting Requirements

Seller shall report quarterly spend and savings achieved by the use of the resulting ICPT Agreement. Savings shall be determined by calculating the difference between the minimum discount of 20% and any additional discount extended beyond that discount because of individual Market Basket and or Registered Pricing achieved at a particular site.

The Seller has been provided with the current ICPT Spend and Savings Report template and agrees to provide the information on a quarterly basis as required. The First Quarter covers October 1 through December 31, the Second Quarter covers January 1 through March 31, the Third Quarter covers April 1 through June 30, and the Fourth Quarter covers July 1 through September 30 of each year. The Seller agrees that they will be responsible for the reporting on both the spend and savings and not any small business resellers that might be utilized by sites.
